

## **(BLXT) ME146 DB repaints destinations pack (Train Simulator 2014)**

### **Introduction**

On rail-sim.de and trainworks.eu you may find two DB repaints of the RSC ME146 pack. These repaints are still including some destination blinds, but I wanted to extend that a little bit. The concerned repaints are Trainworks'one and trainer & Nikt's one. They can download from here:

### **How do I install the pack ?**

For both repaints, follow these steps:

- 1) Open the folder of the chosen repaint included in this archive
- 2) Copy its content to the folder Assets\RSC\ of your railworks directory. Click OK when Windows is asking you to merge the folders and replace the files.
- 3) Clear Train Simulator's cache.
- 4) Restart the program. You will now be able to use the pack.

### **How do I use the pack ?**

It's quite simple. When inserting DB repaints of Metronom vehicles (both engine and carriages) in the scenario editor, you can change their destination by double-clicking on them. In the window appearing on the right of the screen, you find their number which is preceded by a letter. This letter is related to a destination. If you change it, the destination blind also changes.

Here under are the table for both engine and carriages that are presenting you the destinations settings. You will note that some destinations are not operated with a BR146, but that was easier to do it in that way.
