Installation

1. Unzip the file to a place where you can find it easily (Best to use the desktop)
2. Go to your Train Simulator root folder (normally .../steam/steamapps/common/railworks) and open the “*utilities*” application
3. Click on “*package manager*”, then click on “*Install*” and search for the “.rwp” file.
4. **IMPORTANT!** Once installed, open Train Simulator and clear the cache!
