"Grüezi mitenand": Scenario package for the B42 Rail "Zürich – Olten" route

I would like to thank you for your interest in this scenario package. Please read this document carefully in order to prevent unnecessary problems.

1. Introduction

Along the publication of the "Zurich – Olten" route, created by B42 Rail, the Train Simulator gets one of the most important train routes one can find in the Swiss railway system. Due to the realization of all line branches in between those both cities, there are many possibilities in terms of scenario building. As the route is delivered without any scenarios or Quick Drive, I decided to create this little scenario package so newbies can have a look at this beautiful route as well. Especially because it is about having a first impression, the scenarios here are not that difficult. More complex scenarios will come later for sure. Due to the massive track systems, the TS reaches its limits even with a 64-bit version. Since I don't have the best computer at my disposal, I was unfortunately forced to place performance-preserving trains in some places and therefore - especially in the Zurich area - I had to leave out some static rolling stock and AI trains. Nevertheless, there is a lot going on on the tracks. However, a computer with a minimum of 8 gigabytes of RAM and the usage of the 64-bit version is required.

2. Included scenarios

Those scenarios are included:

I. 203_ZH_OLT_I_IC 5 Geneva Airport – St. Gallen (Genf Flughafen – St. Gallen)

Currently, you are in Olten and you are going to take this IC
5 service Geneva Airport – St. Gallen. You will ride nonstop
to Zurich central station, where a colleague takes over. Due
to problems with the RABDe 500-trains which are used
normally on this line, you have a replacement composition.

II. 203_ZH_OLT_II_S 12 Brugg AG - Schaffhausen

You have now once again served the S 12 of the Zurich S-Bahn between Brugg AG and Schaffhausen. Now your last tour has finally begun before it is time for your well-earned evening. It is Saturday evening and the party people of the Zurich area are on their way to the Swiss metropolis. You will travel as far as Zurich HB, where a colleague will take the train to Schaffhausen.

III. 203_ZH_OLT_III_IR 37 Zürich HB – Basel SBB

 Hello, my fellow early birds! You are driving the first InterRegio 37 Zurich - Basel of the day on the section Zurich HB - Aarau. You have caught a bound without FV-Dosto.
