What is Project S-Bahn?

This project was initially my private “playground” to test rolling stock and all my assets that I have created for TS. Because I never had any intention to share this route it lacks things like Quickdrive.

Originally there was only the S-Bahn line. The diesel branch line was a later addition and is actually a “bonus”.

The S-Bahn line runs from East to West and in the middle there is a big city. The route lies in Austria and is fictitious although I have taken many inspirations from real world routes.

This product is and stays freeware!

All assets which I have created especially for this route are included in the download (see installation guide). These assets are freeware and must not be used in other projects without my permission.

Installation

1. Unzip the file to a place where you can find it easily (Best to use the desktop)
2. Go to your Train Simulator root folder (normally .../steam/steamapps/common/railworks) and open the “*utilities*” application
3. Click on “*package manager*”, then click on “*Install*” and search for the “.*Project_SBahn.rwp*” file.
4. **IMPORTANT!** Once installed, open Train Simulator and clear the cache!
5. **Enjoy!**

Known Problems

- When you create a scenario with a freight train it is best to set it as a passenger train in the scenario editor. This will avoid incorrect speeding warnings.
