Good morning,

today, you are driving an ICE 3 (BR 403) as ICE 529 coming from Dortmund Hbf on the section from Bochum Hbf to Duisburg Hbf. There, a colleague will take over in the direction of Munich Hbf. Your departure is at 07:37. Have fun!

You don't have to use the maximum speed on the section between Bochum and Essen, there are a lot of reserves in the timetable. Also, you still have the RE 11 in front of you, which will slow you down a bit if you are traveling too fast.

The AI passenger traffic is based on a timetable from June 25, 2021, but unfortunately cannot be implemented completely realistically due to limitations imposed by the Scenario Designer.

If you don't own one of the optional add-ons, you will have to change or remove the corresponding AI trains yourself in the scenario editor.
