Additional Background Information from Livery Authors

Chiltern Railways Class168/2

This is a representation of the Chiltern Railways corporate livery as carried by units 168214–168219.

These units are based at Wembley Traction Maintenance Depot which is operated by Chiltern Railways. They run services on the London to Aylesbury Line and the Chiltern Main Line.

ND versions are driving vehicle units that have no driver. These should be placed at the rear of the consist. If your consist is a four-car unit, it should contain DMSL-MSL-MSL2-DMCL units. The units are automatically numbered in the range 168214-168219. The number and destination can be manually changed in the usual way. This reskin is provided with custom destination for the Chiltern Railways network. These are:

Deutsche Bahn - Destination headcode

The destination headcode is set within the scenario editor through the numbering of the train. It is built like this:

DVVVVVUUUUUU

D is the destination code, see below

V is the vehicle number on the side of the train

U is the unit number at the front of the train

If you enter this code: m60434170434 you would get a train to Siegen HBF with front number 170434 and vehicle number 60434. When the train is placed in the editor, it's default numbering is "b170xxx" - which would be "Sonderfahrt" or "special train" in english.

East Anglia Class 170/2 Turbostar Pack

This pack contains six livery variations that have been carried by Turbostar DMU's 170201 - 170208 (3 car) and 170270 - 170273 (2 car) between 1999 and present. All of these units are based at Crown Point Traction Maintenance Depot at Norwich and operate services in Anglia.

Anglia Railways ordered two batches of Turbostars in 1997 and consequently they received eight 3car units in 1999. These units operated services on the Great Eastern Main Line, augmenting the Class 86 locomotive-hauled services. The second batch of four 2-car units was delivered in 2002 to coincide with the introduction of the new Norwich-Cambridge direct services operated by Anglia Railways. All of the units were delivered in Anglia Railways' corporate colours of white and turquoise with subtle variations to the livery between the two batches of units.

In 2004 the new Greater Anglia franchise was won by National Express Group (NEG) which set up a subsidiary company called One to operate the franchise. One revised the diagrams which the Turbostars operated; the 3-car units were used on peak Wherry Lines services and London-Lowestoft direct services meanwhile the 2-car units mostly operated the Norwich-Cambridge shuttle services. All of the 3-car units were repainted blue and featured One's 'rainbow stripes' and logo decals. Only one of the 2-car units was treated to the same rebranding (no. 170270).

In 2008, NEG rebranded the franchise National Express East Anglia (NXEA). The London-Lowestoft direct services were withdrawn and the 3-car units moved to operating the Norwich-Cambridge services to improve capacity. The rainbow stripes decals were removed and a white 'pinstripe' added along the length of each vehicle of all twelve units which featured the NXEA logo.



The Greater Anglia franchise was passed on to Greater Anglia in 2012 which operates much the same diagrams that NXEA formed. NXEA branding was removed from all vehicles in the fleet and Greater Anglia decals affixed onto the 'pinstripes'.

- The content may be edited by a Freeware Pack administrator to improve the realism of the item. This is primarily used for rolling stock donations and their physics (braking, loading etc parameters).

You may opt out of this condition if you do not want any improvements to be made to your donations by informing a Freeware Pack administrator

• Freeware Packs may be distributed on UKTS CD's to provide an alternative to those without broadband Internet access and so they may be given away at UKTS Live events
