Traffic seems fairly heavy today, as some goods traffic has been sent this way rather than via Banbury. May be hard work today with a Class 31. This new version is set in 1988.

This is a rendition of the twelfth in the series, with the twist of being set a few years earlier in 1976 when the Deltics ruled the East Coast, and the High Speed Train was still a concept for the future, after the first few deliveries to the GWML...

One of the few through services from Sunderland to Kings Cross is featured in this Snacktime scenario. Quite a simple one this, just enjoy the passing traffic while you make sure you keep to any speed limits. Oh, nearly forgot to tell you, that this train stops at Northallerton as well!

Take this Deltic hauled 12.28 from Sunderland through on to the ECML from the signal in front as soon as it allows you, on a cloudy but warm and dry September afternoon.

The Sixteenth in the series takes you to Sheffield during the 'Miners Fortnight'.

Again the Asset list is short and the scenario is still fully featured but it can be finished in approx 32mins.

Good use is also made of the UKTS Freeware Project packs as listed below.

A few slight stock omissions have been made to ensure a low asset count. All items used are currently available (at the moment). Feel free to add any others if you have them, and are competent with either RW_Tools or the built in Editor. All trains are clearly itemised. Note as always we cannot guarantee all 'user made' swaps to be successful. Good luck.

Introduction and briefing

It's that legendary fortnight when most of South Yorkshire as well as a number of other mining areas goes on holiday! Always ready to make the most of it BR will be running a large number of special trains, some of which are simple day trips, including the one you are about to drive today. Lines are slightly quieter than usual, but there's still a fair amount of traffic around, as not all of the local industries close down, and the already mined coal still needs to be moved.

Take your stock into the platform at Sheffield Victoria, today you are driving a B1 hauled special to Scarborough. You will be allowed into the platform after the early express to Manchester London Road has passed, and please don't forget to request passage from the sidings (TAB) before proceeding. Stop at Deepcar before travelling as far as Penistone, where your scenario will end. You should be able to arrive at Penistone a couple of minutes early with good driving.

Note - The stop point at Penistone is approx a coach length short of the signal. A driver is standing there.

Again the Asset list is as short as we can make it and the scenario is still fully featured, but it can be finished in approx 30mins. Good use is also made of the UKTS Freeware Project packs as listed below.

A few stock compromises have been made to ensure the lowest possible asset count. All items used here are currently available. Feel free to add more appropriate items if you have them, and you are fully competent with either RW_Tools or the built in Editor. A decision has been made to represent all the EMU services with the Class 166 as a fake 466 for ease and general availability, you may change this if you wish.

Introduction and briefing:

No excuses for this one, thought it would be good to see Gresley A4 60007 on the Mayflower line. Start at Harwich Town, picking up steam enthusiasts at all the stations for a long run up to the Settle and Carlisle. Keep to your speed limits and take the opportunity to enjoy both the excellent (and free) route and this superb engine along it.

Make sure all your passengers are aboard, departure is at 07.30, so plenty of time to take a few photos of this magnificent engine before we go. Some stations have short platforms so concentrate on making sure the leading 3 or 4 coaches (at least) are positioned correctly.

Set during the last steam days along this branch, the ex GWR locos are increasingly being replaced by BR Standard types, including some Ivatt ex LMS types, one of which you will be driving today.

A couple of years more and all these will be diesels, they have already started arriving on the main lines, a few of which are to be seen as you take your train through.

Today you will drive a morning peak train to Truro. Starting at the platform at Falmouth, your train is due out at 8.15. Open your doors for any last passengers. Make all the stops this morning, and try to be on time at Truro. Mind any signals, they will not all be green!

Conditions of Use

Anyone using content in the freeware packs must not do anything that would break the “Licensing Conditions for Donated Content”. In addition to this the following conditions also apply:

- Content may **NOT** be used to make profit. This includes (but is not limited to) using content as a requirement, dependency or packaging with any payware, donationware or profit making items without the express permission being granted by the author of the assets
- You may re-skin, distribute and re-package content with any freeware route or project but where possible you should list the relevant Freeware Pack as a requirement for a route, scenario etc rather than including the content with your route

These conditions are designed to ensure that content donated freely by members of the community remains free. Respect other people's work and do not put the future of the packs at risk by careless actions.

Licensing Conditions for Donated Content

To ensure that assets remain permanently available to route builders once donated contributors must agree to the following conditions:

- Content may NOT be withdrawn from the pack after it has been donated
- All content may be used, distributed, re-skinne and re-packaged with any freeware route.
- The complete pack may be hosted on any website providing no profit is made by offering the download
- The content may be edited by a Freeware Pack administrator so that it fits in with the standardised pack structure
- The content may be edited by a Freeware Pack administrator to improve the realism of the item. This is primarily used for rolling stock donations and their physics (braking, loading etc parameters).

You may opt out of this condition if you do not want any improvements to be made to your donations by informing a Freeware Pack administrator

- Freeware Packs may be distributed on UKTS CD's to provide an alternative to those without broadband Internet access and so they may be given away at UKTS Live events

Licensing Conditions for Hosting Packs

The following conditions apply to anyone wishing to host the packs on a site other than UKTS:

- **Permission must be granted by UKTS before packs may be hosted on alternative sites**
- The download must be available for free
- No profit may be made by offering the download
- A link to the original UKTS download must be provided on the download page
- The date and version number of the pack must be clearly given on the download page
- You must email FreewarePacks@rwdecal.co.uk supplying a valid email address and link to the download - This ensure we can contact you (the host) when a new version is released making it easy for you to update your download
- You must remove the download at the request of a UKTS Freeware Pack administrator
