A custom version specially produced for the UKTS Freeware Project, with changes from the previous version and lower stock requirements, and is designed for the Edinburgh to Glasgow route DLC.



This UKTS version is set 7 years later than the standard rendition, and goes beyond the 'Baby Sulzer' years. The Sprinters have yet to arrive....

Take an early morning fast service from Edinburgh Waverley to Perth on a wet and really miserable October day in 1985. All is set up ready for an ontime departure, the weather has not affected any services up to now. You will still have to thrash your engine, as the schedule is tight.

Open your doors ready for a quick getaway at 07.08 prompt. The morning rush is starting so don't hang around. Stops at Haymarket, Polmont and Falkirk Grahamston before your duty ends at Larbert, from where a Perth driver awaits your arrival and you return South East.

A custom version specially produced for the UKTS Freeware Project, with changes from the previous version and lower stock requirements.



Here is the next in this sampler set, showing just the second of a 3 part set along the superb Ay Valley freeware route in the early 1980s.

It continues directly on from Snacktime Scenario No 30 which is available at UKTS 31340. A third in this series is also available at UKTS 31557

Following your arrival at Hazelgrove on the incoming passenger train your next turn takes you through to Shipley Road Mail depot on this parcels train. Note the single odd SK in your formation, as by an agreement with the Post Office, passengers (mostly staff) are allowed to travel on this train, like many parcel services in that era.

Departure should be at 18.05, there are just two stops only before Shipley Road, where another new driver takes over. Yet again a new duty awaits you at the station nearby. Enjoy the scenery along the way.

Total Time Approx 38 mins

The newer BR Class 101 has been used. However this should be freely swappable with RW_Tools if you have the original 101 pack.

Snacktime Scenario No 35

A custom version specially produced for the UKTS Freeware Project, with changes from the previous version and lower stock requirements.



Here is the next in the series for the Just Trains Bristol Avonmouth route, with a substitute loco hauled service from Severn Tunnel junction all stops to Bristol. This follows on from Snacktime Scenario No 29 and features the return working soon afterward.

Following the failure on depot of the rostered DMU, the stock of an incoming Portsmouth service - complete with it's Class 33 - has been utilised today for a quick out and back working to Bristol TM rather than just laying over at Canton Depot for a couple of hours. Snacktime Scenario No 29 available on UKTS covered the trip out, now the Class 33 has been sent for fueling ready for the later Portsmouth service and so this Class 31 has been provided for the run to Cardiff, back into the diagrammed working..

Start outside Bristol after preparing the stock then drive into Temple Meads, the signal in front should have cleared for you to enter the platform. Load your passengers at Bristol for a 13.00 departure. All stops afterwards today, you go as far as Severn Tunnel Junction station where a Canton driver will then take over.

Taking the series to no 40 is this Just Trains Scottish ECML one, based on an engineering service.

Following some track replacement on the Ladybank Perth line you, and your celebrity Aberdeen based EWS Class 33 no 33030 on a very rare (and slightly fictitious) outing will work your Sealion empties after a days work on the Ladybank line, as far as Dundee.

A maximum speed of 60mph applies to this train.

Start at Hilton Junction and proceed to the next signal and await passage onto the main line. One of the PW managers is in the cab with you, drop him off at Perth as you pass. You will be held at Dundee waiting for a spare path North, but for this scenario, it ends there for you.

Take a daytime Ramsgate Charing Cross service from just outside Faversham as far as Rochester on a pleasant summer's day in 1993. Set during those days when Network South East ran the services, and the units had slam doors.

You can go as soon as you get your signal. All stops as far as Rochester, where your duty (on this service) ends.

Snacktime Scenario No 49

For WCML Over Shap. A custom version specially produced for the UKTS Freeware Project, with changes from the previous version and lower stock requirements.



Following the part failure of an earlier service, a Class 37 has been lent from an engineering train on the Heysham line, and a decision to now run this train in the path of the next service which is about to arrive a couple of minutes late. The incoming train will now lay over a bit longer and work a later service to get everything back to normal. A replacement dmu is heading for Lancaster to bring the branch up to strength again.

Prepare for departure at 15.18, then make your stops as normal on this Morecambe - Liverpool through service.

Might give the passengers a faster run than normal, as 3 coaches is a very light load for a Class 37.

Please note that to totally disable most lingering 101 effect the formation has been made up with all trailer cars, a bit of artistic licence being used. Note that should you miss an AWS alarm, the DMU is also AWS fitted and will then apply it to all the vehicles, so a cab cycle would be required.

The times of course are based on a Dmu with a top speed of 70mph, so if you do decide to run at full speed then you can expect an adverse signal somewhere!

These conditions are designed to ensure that content donated freely by members of the community remains free. Respect other people's work and do not put the future of the packs at risk by careless actions.

Licensing Conditions for Donated Content

To ensure that assets remain permanently available to route builders once donated contributors must agree to the following conditions:

- Content may NOT be withdrawn from the pack after it has been donated
- All content may be used, distributed, re-skinned and re-packaged with any freeware route.
- The complete pack may be hosted on any website providing no profit is made by offering the download
- The content may be edited by a Freeware Pack administrator so that it fits in with the standardised pack structure
- The content may be edited by a Freeware Pack administrator to improve the realism of the item. This is primarily used for rolling stock donations and their physics (braking, loading etc parameters).
 - You may opt out of this condition if you do not want any improvements to be made to your donations by informing a Freeware Pack administrator
- Freeware Packs may be distributed on UKTS CD's to provide an alternative to those without broadband Internet access and so they may be given away at UKTS Live events

Licensing Conditions for Hosting Packs

The following conditions apply to anyone wishing to host the packs on a site other than UKTS:

- Permission must be granted by UKTS before packs may be hosted on alternative sites
- The download must be available for free
- No profit may be made by offering the download
- A link to the original UKTS download must be provided on the download page
- The date and version number of the pack must be clearly given on the download page
- You must email FreewarePacks@rwdecal.co.uk supplying a valid email address and link to the download - This ensure we can contact you (the host) when a new version is released making it easy for you to update your download
