

(BLXT) RSC ME146 destinations pack (Train Simulator 2014)

Introduction

Originally RSC ME146 pack is including only 4 different destinations. With this pack, new destinations will be added for the following routes:

- Hamburg – Hannover (KBS 110)
- Hamburg – Bremen (KBS 120)
- Hamburg – Cuxhaven (KBS 121)

I don't know which font type is used on Metronom vehicles displays, but I used the much more similar fonts, I have on my computer.

How do I install the pack ?

Follow these steps:

- 1) Do a backup of both 'Digits.bin' (railworks/Assets/RSC/ClassME146Pack01/RailVehicles/Electric/ME146/Engine/Textures) and 'Metronom_digits.bin' (railworks/Assets/RSC/ClassME146Pack01/RailVehicles/Electric/ME146/Driving Trailer/Engine/Textures) files.
- 2) Copy the content of the folder 'ME146 destinations pack' to the assets folder of your railworks directory. Click OK when Windows is asking you to merge the folders and replace the files.
- 3) Clear Train Simulator's cache.
- 4) Restart the program. You will now be able to use the pack.

How do I use the pack ?

It's quite simple. When inserting Metronom vehicles (both engine and carriages) in the scenario editor, you can change their destination by double-clicking on them. In the window appearing on the right of the screen, you find their number which is preceded by a letter. This letter is related to a destination. If you change it, the destination blind also changes.

Here under are the tables for both engine and carriages that are presenting you the destinations settings. You will note the two following things:

- the engine has more than one letter for the same destination. That's normal and it's related to the carriages destinations. I did it in that way, so that you only will have to use the same letter to put the destinations of an entire train.
- the carriages have two more destinations than the engine. In the reality, these destinations are reached by diesel engines and so the electric BR146 doesn't need them.
